- At least four members that have read the book must participate.
- All participants in conversation must be familiar with the book. This means they will have read at least the introduction to the book and the summary points at the end of each chapter of the book.
- Due to time constraints, I will not spend time in the chat giving an overview or summary of the book. I am donating my time to this chat so we can engage your specific questions and ideas.
- Having me as a guest at your book club does not constitute permission to reproduce any part of my book. If members are unable to purchase the book, please request copies from your local libraries.
- If you would like to troubleshoot particular challenges in your church community related to accessibility issues addressed in the book, please email me your story, along with relevant photographs of spaces, at least a week in advance at summerkinard@gmail.com
